

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY MEETING

GOVT. WOMEN'S COLLEGE, SUNDARGARH ON Dt 25.03.2022 AT 03.00 P.M

The Governing Body Meeting of the Government Women's College, Sundargarh was held on dt 25.03.2022 at 03.00 P.M. in the IQAC Room under the Chairmanship of Sri. SrinibasBariha, Ex-officio Vice President-cum-Secretary in absence of Dr.Smt. Indira Naik, President of Governing Body.

At the outset Smt.Sushama Hasda,Asst. Prof in English and Member of theGoverning Body welcomed the members to the Governing body andread out the proceedings of the last Governing Body Meeting held on dt 27.08.2021. The agenda of the meeting was placed for discussion.As per the agenda various issues were discussed in the meeting and proposals were made for taking remedial measures as follows:

1. Filling of Teaching and Non-Teaching Posts&Creation of new Posts

The members of the Governing Body discussed the above matter and decided to place the matter before honorable Principal Secretary of Higher Education Department, Govt. of Odisha for filling up of the vacancies of teaching &non-teaching Staff on priority basis.

2. Allocation of Fund for engagement of Group“D” employees

Another issue of theinstitution is the deficiency of group- “D” staff in the college. The governing body expressed their concern regarding this issue& they

suggested that they will discuss this problem with the District Administration and request for allocation of fund from DMF to meet the expenses for temporary engagement of the said employees.

3. **Allotment of Government Land and construction of Building for Higher Secondary School**

The members of the Governing body proposed to request the District Administration for allotment of Government land for construction of building for Higher Secondary school separately in the area nearby the institution.

4. **Allotment of Government Land behind the College Campus for playground**

As most of the students of the institution are from the tribal area and they have high potentiality in games and sports, they must be encouraged in this field to practice and explore their potentiality. In this connection the members of the Governing Body expressed their good will for the development of games and sports of girls for which a playground is essential for the college. The members of the Governing Body assured that the matter will be brought to the notice of the District Administration for allotment of Govt. Land behind the College Campus for the purpose of playground.

5. **Allotment of Govt Land for Construction of Staff Quarters:**

It was decided in the meeting that this issue will be brought to the notice of the District Administration for allotment of Government land or quarters adjacent to the college for construction of Staff Quarters.

6. **Shifting of Weight and Measure Office from Hostel Premises:**

The members of the Governing Body said that they will meet the Sub-Collector/Tahsildar to discuss the matter and solve the problem on priority basis to maintain privacy and security of the Boarders.

7. **Construction of Hostel Superintendent Quarters inside the Hostel Premises:**

The members of the body suggested to submit a proposal to the R & B Division, Sundargarh for construction of Superintendent and Deputy Superintendent Quarters inside the Hostel Premises, either from Government Fund or DMF Fund.

8. **IDP related matters:**

It was resolved in the meeting that balance money amounting Rs 5,68,602 in the IDP fund dt 04.10.2021 out of Rs 40,000,00 may be utilized for purchase of laboratory equipment with the permission of the Govt. It was decided to place the matter to Government authority and get necessary permission for proper utilization of balance amount.

9. **Installation of High Mast Light in the College Campus :**

The members of Governing Body assured that two high mast lights will be installed for the safety of the institution and it may be arranged from DMF fund with the approval of the of the Collector and district authority.

10. **Taking over the charges of Library and Dept of Home Science after retirement of Jr. Librarian and Demonstrator**

It was decided by the members of the Governing Body that Sri. Rasananda Kalo, Retd. Library Attendant will take over the charges of Library till alternative
